


Exploring color widens the eyes and connects you more deeply to your creative spirit.

Located in the historic Mount Tabor neighborhood, TaborSpace is an innovative grassroots community center sharing sacred space with an old stone church.


The ArtSpace is a comfortable, spacious, well-lit room on the second floor of the Parish House with a large wooden table and stunning views of Portland.

Three-Day Color & Polymer Retreat Winter: Feb 24-26 Spring: May 11-13

Throw out the books. Forget the color wheel.

Come immerse yourself in color just for the fun of it!

Maggie will share an expanded version of her

Smashing Color Workshop while teaching the basics of her Color-Wash technique in polymer clay.

Spend the mornings doing fun color exercises similar to those in Maggie and Lindly Haunani's popular book "Color Inspirations: Techniques and Jewelry Projects for Creating Successful Palettes."

Spend the afternoons making jewelry using variations of the Color-Wash technique. The projects will include a Poetry Bracelet and a Split Ring necklace. All polymer clay and materials are provided. No polymer clay experience is necessary. Beginners are welcome!

### **Finding Your Color Voice**

Five-Day Personal Color Retreat Summer: Aug 6-10 Fall: Sep 10-14

Everyone has a unique and instinctive sense of color. Come spend an entire week finding your color voice, supported and inspired by artists who share your passion for color. The morning exercises will use polymer clay. The afternoon is your time for personal color explorations in the medium of your choice.

We will start by making a color collage and then design a small project for daily explorations in many different color combinations.

Maggie will teach in the morning, guide the studio time in the afternoon, and be available in the evenings for optional one-on-one mentoring. The focus will be on developing a personal palette, adding depth to your work and making colors glow!
