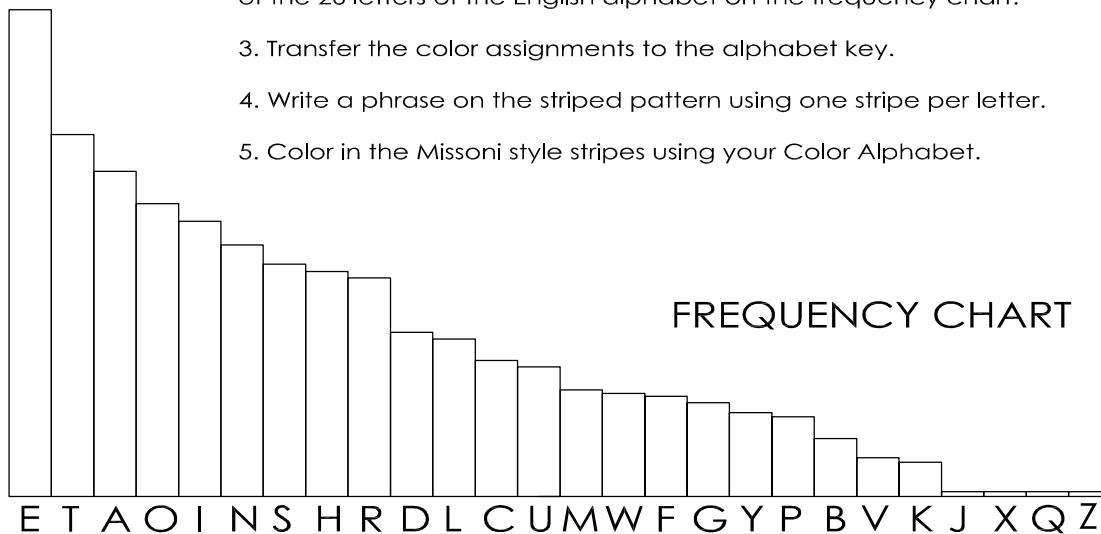


SMASHING COLOR

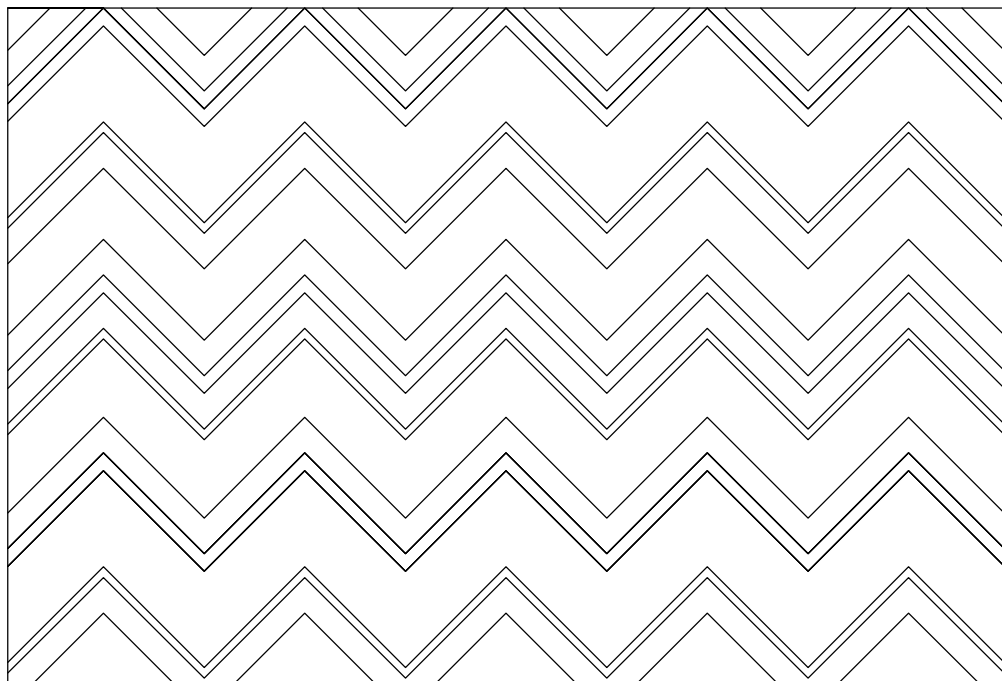
Exploring Rule-Based Color Selection

1. Select 26 distinctly different colors from a box of 64 Crayola crayons.
2. Come up with a rule for assigning one color to correspond to each of the 26 letters of the English alphabet on the frequency chart.
3. Transfer the color assignments to the alphabet key.
4. Write a phrase on the striped pattern using one stripe per letter.
5. Color in the Missoni style stripes using your Color Alphabet.
