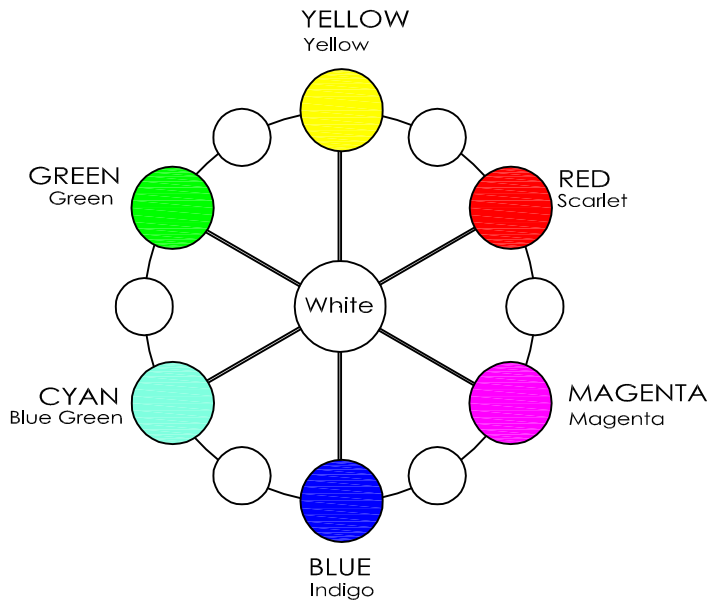


# FOUR COMPLEMENTARY WHEELS

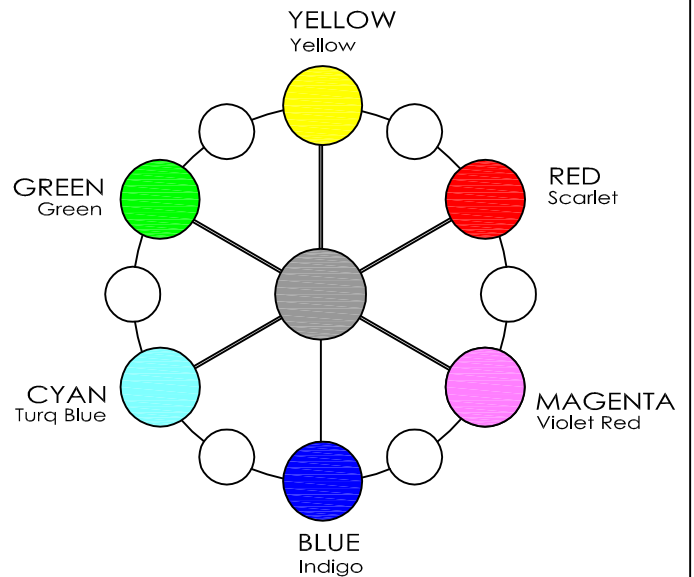
COMPLEMENTS ARE OFTEN DEFINED AS TWO COLORS OPPOSITE EACH OTHER ON A COLOR WHEEL THAT MIX TOGETHER TO MAKE A NEUTRAL. THE COLOR WHEELS BELOW SHOW FOUR DIFFERENT SYSTEMS AND THE NEUTRALS THAT RESULT FROM MIXING COMPLEMENTARIES.

## SPECTRAL COMPLEMENTS



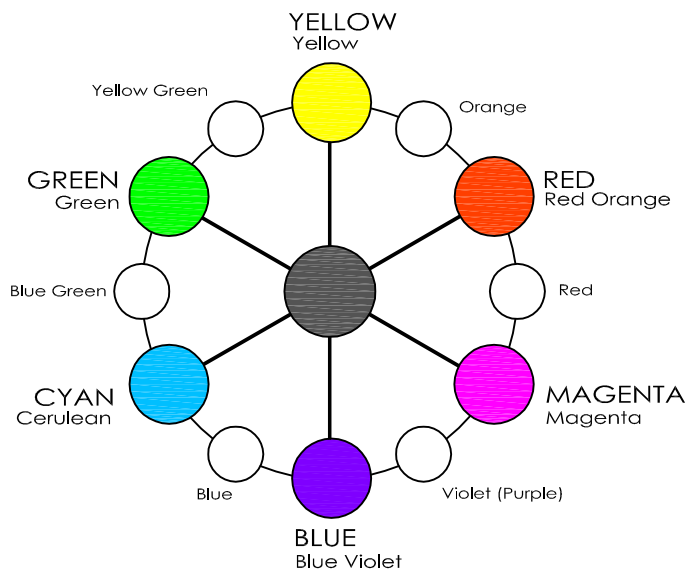
LIGHT MIXING

## OPTICAL COMPLEMENTS



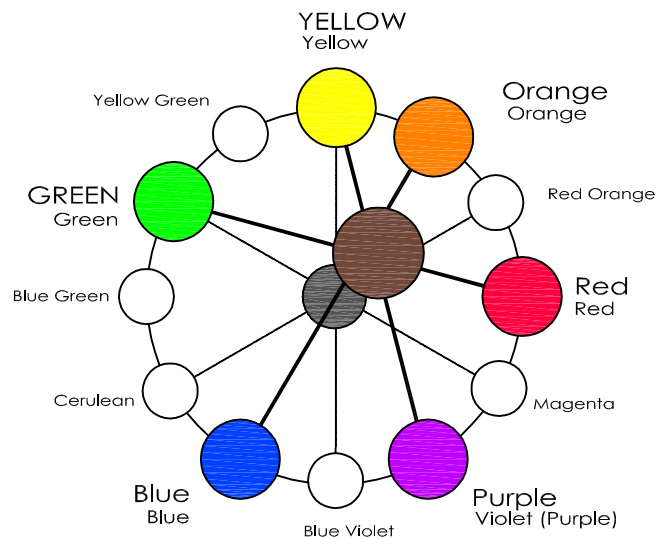
OPTICAL MIXING

NEUTRAL = DARK GRAY

## TRADITIONAL COMPLEMENTS



RYB MIXING  
NEUTRAL = BROWN/MUD
