

COLOR TRIANGLE #1

SORT A BOX OF 64 CRAYOLA CRAYONS INTO THE TRIANGLE

Note: This is a two layered triangle. The first layer has the Rainbow and Earth colors. Imagine the second layer as another triangle above the first triangle. This triangle has the lighter versions of the rainbow and earth colors.

DIRECTIONS ; COLOR AND THEN CUT OUT THE CIRCLES FROM HANDOUT #2

1. POSITION RAINBOW COLORS ALONG THE OUTSIDE LINES OF THE TRIANGLE.
2. POSITION THE EARTH COLORS INSIDE THE TRIANGLE WITH THE NEUTRALS IN THE MIDDLE.
3. POSITION RAINBOW PASTELS OUTSIDE THE TRIANGLE CLOSE TO THE COLOR THEY COME FROM.
4. POSITION EARTH PASTELS ON TOP OF THE EARTH COLORS THEY COME FROM.

TIPS

1. AS COLORS GET LIGHTER THEY TEND TO LOOK YELLOWER. MAC AND CHEESE IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF THIS. IT IS A LIGHTER VERSION OF RED ORANGE BUT LOOKS AS IF IT BELONGS IN THE ORANGE FAMILY.

2. AS COLORS GET DARKER THEY TEND TO LOOK BLUER. ASPARAGUS IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF THIS. IT IS A DARKER VERSION OF YELLOW GREEN BUT LOOKS AS IF IT BELONGS IN THE GREEN FAMILY.
